Local Law 43 of 2004 In July 2004, the City Council passed Int. No. 81-A [Local Law 43 of 2004], which bans the sale and installation of after-market audible car alarms that are illegal to use in New York City. Current law prohibits the operation of audible car alarms that are activated by something other than by direct physical contact or a remote activation device and alarms that sound for longer than three minutes.

Local Law 113 of 2005 In December 2005, the City Council passed Int. No. 397-A [Local Law 113 of 2005], which updated and amended the City's comprehensive Noise Control Code.
