Summary of Local Law 2025/035 (Int. 1101-A-2024): Requiring NYPD to Address Identity Theft

Purpose:

This law mandates that the New York City Police Department (NYPD) improve public education and officer training regarding identity theft.

Key Provisions:

1. Public Information (Section 14-198a):

- NYPD must post identity theft information on its website, including:
 - What constitutes identity theft.
 - How identity theft occurs and how stolen information is used.
 - Tips on protecting personal information.
 - How to report identity theft, including filing procedures and required documentation.

2. Officer Training (Section 14-198b):

- Mandatory identity theft training for:
 - All new recruits at the Police Academy.
 - All existing officers who haven't received such training previously.

3. Training Content (Section 14-198c):

- Training must cover:
 - Legal definitions and conduct constituting identity theft.
 - Acceptable forms of proof and documentation to support complaints.
 - NYPD protocols for handling identity theft cases.

Effective Date:

April 1, 2026.

Sponsors:

Introduced by Council Member Yusef Salaam and co-sponsored by 13 others.

Legislative Status:

Enacted on March 29, 2025 as Local Law 35 of 2025.
