# Summary of Res. 0853-2025: Allowing VIN Use in Notices of Violation When License Plates Are Obscured

#### **Purpose:**

This resolution urges the New York State Legislature and Governor to amend the Vehicle and Traffic Law (VTL) to allow Vehicle Identification Numbers (VINs) to be used in Notices of Violation in place of license plate numbers when a vehicle's plates are missing, obscured, distorted, or concealed.

#### **Key Points:**

## 1. Current Enforcement Challenge:

- The VTL requires traffic and parking summonses (Notices of Violation) to include a **license plate number**.
- If the plate is **missing**, **altered**, **or unreadable**, a violation can be dismissed.
- This limits enforcement and enables **toll evasion**, **red-light camera evasion**, and **hit-and-run obstruction**.

#### 2. Public Safety & Fiscal Impact:

- Vehicles with concealed plates undermine:
  - o **Camera-based enforcement** (e.g., for speeding, red lights, tolls).
  - o **Investigations** into vehicle-related crimes and crashes.
- The MTA reports revenue losses from toll evasion due to these practices.
- In 2024, NYPD reportedly **seized over 7,500 vehicles** with illegal plate modifications.

## 3. Proposed Solution:

- Allow authorities to list a **VIN**—a vehicle's unique serial number—as the primary identifier in Notices of Violation when the license plate is illegible or absent.
- VINs are already tied to state **registration databases**, allowing proper identification of the vehicle owner.

#### 4. Legislative Ask:

• Amend **VTL §238** to permit VINs as a valid identifier **in lieu of** a license plate number under specific conditions.
