REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NEW DESIGNATION AND CHANGES IN THE DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS TO RECEIVE FUNDING IN THE FISCAL 2009 EXPENSE BUDGET

The Committee on Finance, to which was referred the above-captioned resolution, respectfully submits to The Council of the City of New York the following

REPORT

<u>Introduction.</u> The Council of the City of New York (the "Council") annually adopts the City's budget covering expenditures other than for capital projects (the "expense budget") pursuant to Section 254 of the Charter. On June 29, 2008, the Council adopted the expense budget for fiscal year 2009 with various programs and initiatives (the "Fiscal 2009 Expense Budget").

Analysis. This Resolution, dated May 20, 2009, approves new designations and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local, aging, and youth discretionary funding in accordance with the Fiscal 2009 Expense Budget, and approves the addition of fiscal conduits for certain organizations receiving local, aging and youth discretionary funding. In addition, this Resolution approves the new designations and changes in the designation of certain organizations to receive funding pursuant to certain initiatives in the Fiscal 2009 Expense Budget.

In an effort to continue to make the budget process more transparent, the Council is providing a list setting forth new designation and/or changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local, aging, and youth discretionary funding (or Council discretionary funding), as well as new designations and/or changes in the designation of certain organizations to receive funding pursuant to certain initiatives in the Fiscal 2009 Expense Budget.

This resolution sets forth new designations and specific changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local initiative funding, as described in Chart 1, attached hereto as Exhibit A, sets forth new designations and changes in aging discretionary funding, as described in Chart 2, attached thereto as Exhibit B, sets forth new designations and specific changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving youth discretionary funding, as described in Chart 3, attached thereto as Exhibit C, and sets forth the new designations of certain organizations that will receive funding pursuant to certain initiatives in the Fiscal 2009 Expense Budget, as described in Charts 4-10, attached hereto as reflected in Exhibits D-J.

The Charts, attached to the resolution, contain the following information: name of the council member(s) designating the organization to receive funding or name of the initiative, as set forth

in Adjustments Summary/Schedule C/ Fiscal 2009 Expense Budget, dated June 29, 2008; name of the organization; organization's Employer Identification Number (EIN), if applicable; agency name; increase or decrease in funding; name of fiscal conduit, if applicable; and the EIN of the fiscal conduit, if applicable.

Specifically, Chart 1 sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local discretionary funding. Chart 1 also reflects the addition of Polonians Organized to Minister Our Community (POMOC), Inc. and the Metropolitan New York Coordinating Council on Jewish Poverty, Inc. as fiscal conduits for the St. Stanislaus Lostka Church and the Jewish Community Council of Canarsie, Inc, respectively. Chart 1 also indicates funding withdrawal for the Chaim Meir Camp Fund.

Chart 2 sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving aging discretionary funding. Chart 2 also reflects the addition of Jewish Association for Services for the Aged (JASA), and the Metropolitan New York Coordinating Council on Jewish Poverty, Inc. as fiscal conduits for Temple Emmanuel at Parkchester-Sisterhood; and Council of Jewish Organizations of Flatbush, Inc., Jackson heights-Elmhurst Kehilah, Inc., Jewish Community Council of Kings Bay, Inc., and Washington Heights-Inwood preservation and Restoration Corporation, respectively.

Chart 3 sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving youth discretionary funding. Chart 3 also reflects the addition of the Metropolitan New York Coordinating Council on Jewish Poverty, Inc as a fiscal conduit for Project Lead, Inc. Chart 3 also indicates a fund withdrawal for the Flatbush Youth Association in the amount of \$2,000.

Chart 4 sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to the Cultural After School Adventure Initiative.

Chart 5 sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to the Immigrant Opportunity Initiative.

Chart 6 sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to the Healthy Aging Initiative.

Chart 7 sets forth the new designation and changes in certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to the Infant Mortality Reduction Initiative. Specifically, Chart 7 reflects EIN 13-2612532 as the proper EIN for Hunts Point Multi-Service, Inc.

Chart 8 sets forth the new designation and changes in certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to the Transportation Costs Initiative. Specifically, Chart 8 reflects EIN 13-2612532 as the proper EIN for Hunts Point Multi-Service, Inc-Maria Isabel Senior Center.

Chart 9 sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to the Comprehensive Podiatric Medical Screening Initiative. As

indicated in Chart 9, funding in the amount of \$25,000 for Touro College-Project Aspire has been withdrawn. This money will be used to fund Touro College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Chart 10 sets forth the new designation and changes in certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to the NYA Street Outreach Initiative within the Department of Youth and Community Development. This chart indicates a technical correction to the source of funding. In a Council Resolution dated April 22, 2009, this initiative was incorrectly listed as receiving funds from the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. These organizations are funded through the NYA Street Outreach Initiative within the Department of Youth and Community Development. As indicated in Chart 10, funding in the amount of \$8,774.66 for Brooklyn Center for the Urban Environment has been withdrawn. This money will be used to fund the City Parks Foundation.

It is to be noted that organizations identified in the attached Charts with an asterisk (*) have not yet completed or began the prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services (for organizations receiving more than \$10,000) or by the Council (for organizations receiving \$10,000 or less total). Organizations identified without an asterisk have completed the appropriate prequalification review.

<u>Description of Above-captioned Resolution.</u> In the above-captioned resolution, the Council would approve the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations to receive funding in the Fiscal 2009 Expense Budget. Such resolution would take effect as of the date of adoption.
