  - Expanded direct dental service programs in school settings.
  - Strengthened program evaluation of direct service programs.
  - Strengthened oral health training & education:
    - Designed training module on fluoride varnish for medical providers in school settings
    - Provided support to work with dentists throughout NYC on tobacco cessation counseling with their patients.
    - Expanded staffing to strengthen oral health surveillance efforts, program evaluations, care coordination, and case management.
