

- Updated oral health provider list.

- Expanded staffing to strengthen oral health surveillance efforts, program evaluations, care coordination, and case management.
- Strengthened oral health training & education:
  - Established training module on fluoride varnish for medical providers in school settings to educate all providers on current best practices.
  - Incorporated oral health messages in a medical provider detailing campaign. Initiative rolled out in 2017. Trained 50 providers in NYC thus far.
- Expansion of outreach
  - Expanded direct dental service programs in school settings. Expanded from approximately 400 schools in 2016-2017 to approximately 480 in 2017-2018 SY.
  - Purchased portable equipment and dental materials for school-based dental providers, to strengthen provision of their services.
  - Strengthened program evaluation of direct service programs through increased qualitative and quantitative assessments.
  - Youth served in FY17 through the direct service programs:
