

## NYC Health + Hospitals Bed Utilization Report, FY 2017

In fiscal year-ending 2017, NYC Health + Hospitals eleven acute hospitals had an average daily census of 3,518, with an overall average length of stay of 6.7 days. Its 4,477 beds had an average occupancy rate of 77.2%.

Its five SNF facilities had a combined average daily census of 1,882 with an overall average length of stay of 351 days. Its 2,037 beds had an average occupancy rate of 92.7%.
