

## NYC Health + Hospitals Bed Utilization Report, FY 2018

In fiscal year-ending 2018, NYC Health + Hospitals eleven acute hospitals had an average daily census of 3,409, with an overall average length of stay of 6.7. Its 4,235 beds had an average occupancy rate of 79.7.

Its five SNF facilities had a combined average daily census of 1,842 with an overall average length of stay of 343.5 days. Its 2,059 beds had an average occupancy rate of 89.7.
