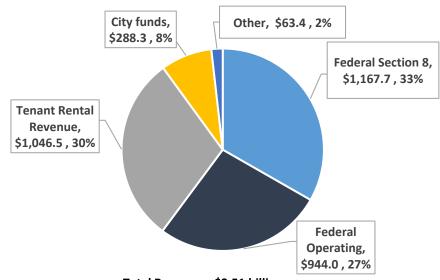

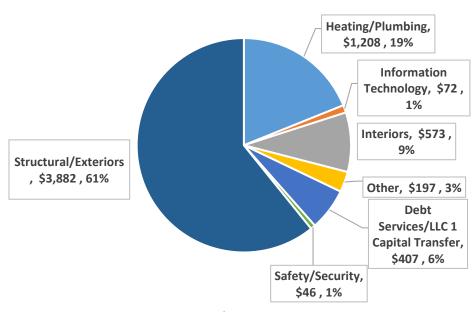

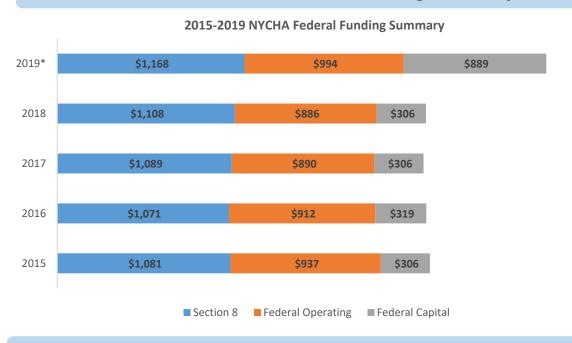
2019-2023 Capital Plan Overview

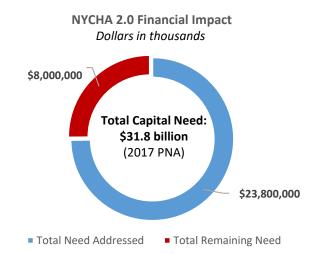

Unmet Capital Needs

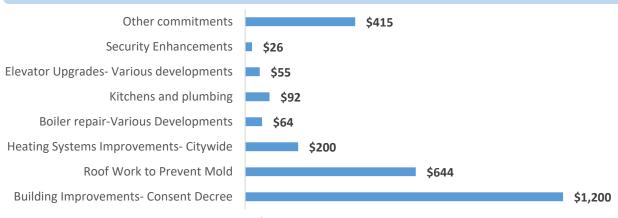


Largest Fiveyear capital need: \$12.6 billion for apt interiors
