Introduction

In accordance with the condition of the funds in unit of appropriation number 003—FY’19, the Department of Finance is required to submit this report to New York City Council. As required, this report provides the number of applications for the Senior Citizen Homeowner Exemption (SCHE), the Disabled Homeowner Exemption (DHE), the Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption (SCRIE), the Disability Rent Increase Exemption (DRIE), and the Not-For-Profit (NFP) exemption received, disaggregated by type, including the number processed, approved, disapproved, and the median number of days it took to process the applications that were processed in FY’18. Such report shall cover the period beginning July 1, 2017 and ending on June 30, 2018.
