Re: Neighborhood Development Fund (NDF) Allocation

Mr. Speaker:

The Department of City Planning is responsible for regularly reporting the balance of the Neighborhood Development Fund to the New York City Council.

The Neighborhood Development Fund was established in 2015 with a budget of \$1.03B, with \$703M budgeted through the New York City Economic Development Corporation and \$329M within the budget of the Department of Environmental Protection.

Below, please find historical project allocations by neighborhood from the Neighborhood Development Fund, now including Bay Street.
