

FY20 Adult Education Terms & Conditions Report

During the Program Year 2019 – 2020, the DOE served a total of 36,409 Adult Education participants. The drop in participation can be directly tied to the Coronavirus pandemic and student limitations regarding technology. In addition, 1,585 of our adult students earned their High School Equivalency during the 2019 – 2020 program year.

As was stated last year, the accountability measures have changed with the introduction of NYSED's EPE Fast Track initiative. As per NYSED, students participating in EPE Fast Track are not required to be post tested. Additionally, during the remote instruction period all post-testing requirements were lifted by NYSED, meaning new students during the remote period are not part of the NRS cohort (please see the attached memo from NYSED).

The table below shows the breakdown and performance for Program-Year-2019-2020 students who met the NRS accountability measures by program and literacy level.
