Other Adjustments:

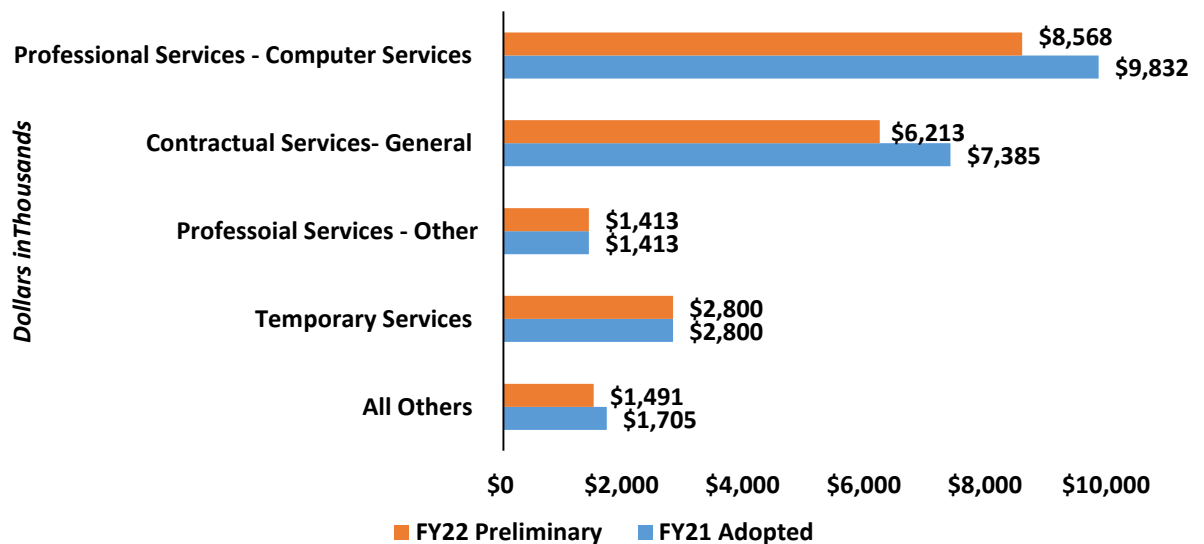

Savings:

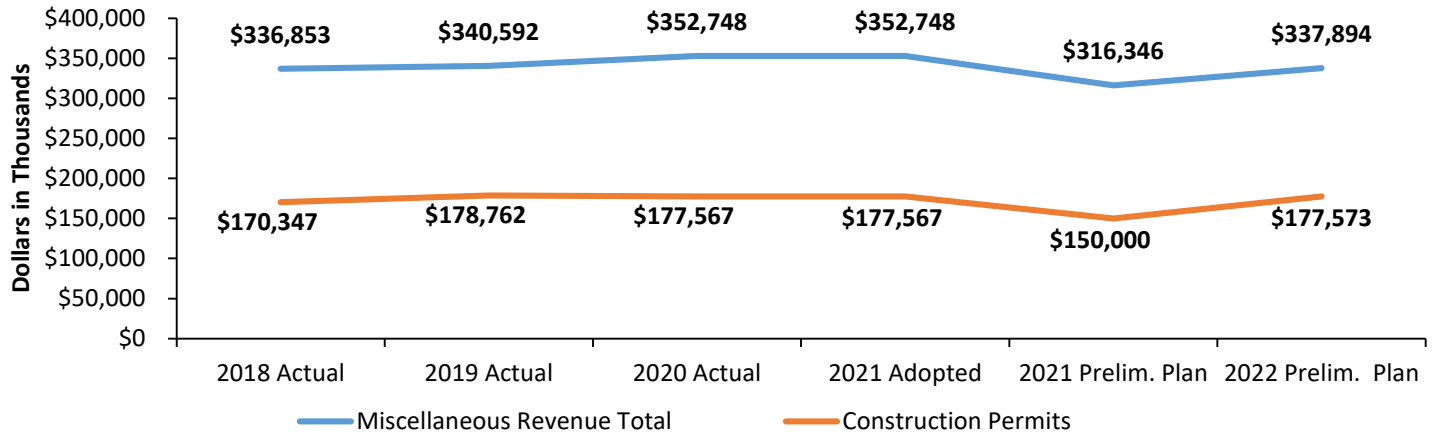
- The Department plans to realize \$2.4 million in PS Savings in Fiscal 2021 and \$4.9 million in Fiscal 2022.

The Department received \$5 million in intra-City funding, an increase of \$2 million from the November Plan.

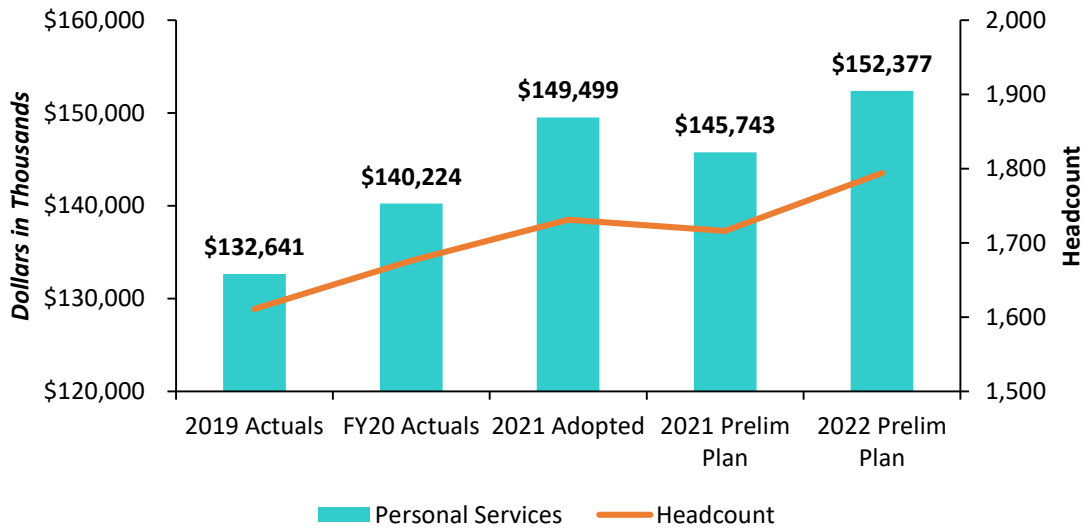
Contract Budget

The Department of Building's headcount has steadily increased since Fiscal 2019. As of January 2021, the Department is operating with a 7.5 percent vacancy rate.

Construction Site Safety
