## NYC Health + Hospitals Bed Utilization Report, FY 2020

In fiscal year-ending 2020, NYC Health + Hospitals eleven acute hospitals had an average daily census of 3,162, with an overall average length of stay of 5.9 days. Its 4,199 beds had an average occupancy rate of 75.3%.

H+H's five SNF facilities had a combined average daily census of 1,666 with an overall average length of stay of 201 days. The 2,099 beds had an average occupancy rate of 79.4%.
