REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NEW DESIGNATION AND CHANGES IN THE DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS TO RECEIVE FUNDING IN THE EXPENSE BUDGET

The Committee on Finance, to which the above-captioned resolution was referred, respectfully submits to The Council of the City of New York the following:

REPORT

<u>Introduction</u>. The Council of the City of New York (the "Council") annually adopts the City's budget covering expenditures other than for capital projects (the "expense budget") pursuant to Section 254 of the Charter. On June 30, 2021, the Council adopted the expense budget for fiscal year 2022 with various programs and initiatives (the "Fiscal 2022 Expense Budget"). On June 13, 2022, the Council adopted the expense budget for fiscal year 2023 with various programs and initiatives (the "Fiscal 2023 Expense Budget").

<u>Analysis</u>. In an effort to continue to make the budget process more transparent, the Council is providing a list setting forth new designations and/or changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving funding in accordance with the Fiscal 2023 and Fiscal 2022 Expense Budgets ("Chart").

This Resolution, dated May 11, 2023, approves the new designations and the changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local and boroughwide discretionary funding and funding for certain initiatives in accordance with the Fiscal 2023 Expense Budget; approves the change in designation of certain organizations receiving aging discretionary funding in accordance with the Fiscal 2022 Expense Budget; and amends the description for the Description/Scope of Services of certain organizations receiving boroughwide discretionary funding in accordance with the Fiscal 2022 Expense Budget. All new designations and changes in designations are as described in the attached Charts and the Resolution text.

It is to be noted that organizations identified in the attached Charts with an asterisk (*) have not yet completed or began the prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services (for organizations to receive more than \$10,000) by the Council (for organizations to receive \$10,000 or less total), or other government agency. Organizations identified without an asterisk have completed the appropriate prequalification review.

It should also be noted that funding for organizations in the attached Charts with a double asterisk (**) will not take effect until the passage of a budget modification.

<u>Description of Above-captioned Resolution.</u> In the above-captioned Resolution, the Council would approve the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations to receive funding in the Fiscal 2023 and Fiscal 2022 Expense Budgets. Such Resolution would take effect as of the date of adoption.
