For the last two quarters of Fiscal Year 2024 (**January 1, 2023 – June 30, 2023**), below please find a breakdown of 911 mental health calls involving persons experiencing mental health crises:

- How many of such calls were received:
  - 0 20, 692 total mental health 911 calls in B-HEARD pilot area
- How many were responded to by NYPD, FDNY and/or B-HEARD team:
  - o 5,095 mental health 911 calls in the pilot area that received a B-HEARD response
- How many people assisted by B-HEARD were:
  - Served onsite: Of the individuals who received a behavioral health assessment, 42% were provided connections to community-based behavioral health services. Of the 42% who received care in the community, 36% were assisted on-site.
  - 2. **Transported to a community-based healthcare:** Of the 42% who received care in the community, **6%** were transported to a community-based healthcare or social service location.
