As of 8/10/26, the City has spent an average of \$366 per household per night for asylum seekers, using cost data through 07/31/26. The projected per diem rate in the FY27 Adopted budget was calculated at \$331 per household per night for asylum seekers. The City calculates per diem rates on a lag due to agency revisions to recent cost estimates. This aggregate average per diem rate per household covers shelter, security, and food for all asylum seekers in the City's care.
