WHERE CAN I GO?

1. The Red Cross's intake center is located at Sunnyside Community Services, located at 43-31 39th Street, Sunnyside, NY 11104
2. You will get assistance with the following:
 - a. Temporary Sheltering/Housing
 - b. Mental Health Assistance
 - c. Financial Assistance
 - d. Health Services
3. Anyone affected by the fire can receive services from the Red Cross and Office of Emergency Management, regardless of immigration status.

WHAT SHOULD I BE DOING?

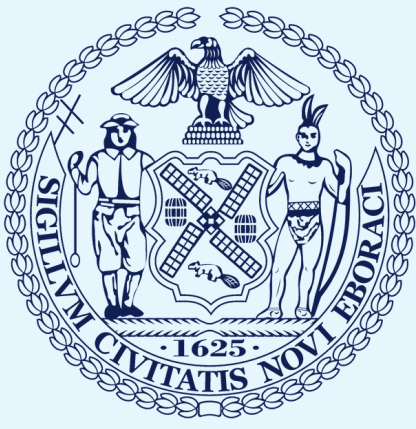
1. Document everything: take photos of your home for future claims
2. Take inventory: write out what has been damaged for future claims
3. If you have Renters Insurance: file your claim, alert insurer
4. Suspend service for your utilities - gas, internet, and electricity
5. Please register with the Red Cross within 14 days

¿DÓNDE PUEDO IR?

1. El centro de admisión de la Cruz Roja está ubicado en Sunnyside Community Services, en la dirección 43-31 39th Street, Sunnyside, NY 11104
2. La Cruz Roja brindará asistencia en las siguientes áreas:
 - a. Refugio Temporal/Vivienda
 - b. Asistencia de Salud Mental
 - c. Asistencia Financiera
 - d. Servicios de Salud
3. Cualquier persona afectada por el incendio puede recibir servicios de la Cruz Roja y la Oficina de Manejo de Emergencias, independientemente de su estatus migratorio.

¿QUÉ DEBERÍA ESTAR HACIENDO?

1. Documenta todo: toma fotos de su hogar para reclamaciones futuras
2. Haga un inventario: anota lo que haya sido dañado para reclamaciones futuras
3. Si tiene un seguro de inquilinos: presenta su reclamación, avise a su aseguradora
4. Suspende el servicio de sus servicios públicos: gas, internet y electricidad
5. Por favor, regístrese con la Cruz Roja dentro de 14 días
